

## Industry Qualifications

### Level 2 Certificate in Driving Goods Vehicles (QCF)

#### Introduction

The revised Skills for Logistics qualifications look different as they all combine Capability (Knowledge) with Competency into a single qualification. They are all mapped directly to the revised National Occupational Standards (NOS) on a one to one basis so that employers, employees and learners can be confident that they meet the skills requirements for our sector.

The qualifications are more flexible and will allow you to achieve the qualification in 'bite-sized pieces'.

#### The Qualification

This qualification is for those who drive goods vehicles in logistics. The qualification now includes the old 'Carry and Deliver' units, these were available as a separate NVQ previously. You will now be able to take the qualification in the vehicle you drive and have the type of vehicle listed on the final qualification certificate:

- Motor Cycle
- Van
- Rigid Vehicle
- Articulated or Draw Bar Vehicle

You can also take the qualification as part of the Driving Goods Vehicles Intermediate Apprenticeship.

Other changes allow you to drive, on either a public or private road, depending on your working environment, to either load or ensure you vehicle is loaded and unloaded correctly. There are 5 mandatory units with a choice of options, depending on the vehicle type to be taken from the groups as shown below. The minimum credit value that must be taken to achieve the qualification is 30 and the maximum credit value is 33.



## Mandatory units

SfL Unit Reference	Title of Unit	Credit
2SfL1	Prepare the vehicle for driving	2
2SfL2	Protect the vehicle and the load	2
2SfL3	Operate and monitor the vehicle systems	3
2SfL4	Manoeuvre the vehicle in restricted spaces	4
2SfL6	Obtain information on the collection and/or delivery of loads	2

## Optional units

1 unit to be taken from each of the following groups 1, 2 and 3

### Group 1

SfL Unit Reference	Title of Unit	Credit
2SfL5	Drive the vehicle in a safe and fuel efficient manner on a public road	6
2SfL5b	Drive the vehicle in a safe and fuel efficient manner on a private road	4

### Group 2

SfL Unit Reference	Title of Unit	Credit
2SfL7	Ensure the vehicle is loaded correctly	4
2SfL7b	Load the vehicle correctly	5

### Group 3

SfL Unit Reference	Title of Unit	Credit
2SfL8	Ensure the vehicle is unloaded correctly	3
2SfL8b	Unload the vehicle correctly	3



#### Group 4

Any combination of units to be taken from Option Group 4 with a **minimum** value of **6 Credits**.

3SfL9	Plan the route and timings for the collection and delivery of goods	6
2SfL10*	Couple and uncouple the vehicle	3
2SfL10b*	Attach and detach vehicle mounted bodies	3
2SfL11	Make an effective contribution to a business in logistics sector	3
2SfL12	Contribute to the provision of customer service in logistics operations	3
2SfL13	Collect and/or deliver goods – (motor cycles and pedal cycles)	2
2SfL14	Dealing with payment transactions in logistics operations	2

\*Note that it is not permissible for those undertaking the qualification on a motor cycle to take units 2SfL10 and 2SfL10b
